Glossary Continued

Resmethrin: A very effective synthetic pyrethrin that is used in formulas usually found in food processing plants. Excellent stable product, relatively non-toxic to humans and other animals.

Respirator: Breathing protection device. Respirators filter out particles, vapors and more depending on the type of media chosen.

Solution: Mixture of materials in which all materials are completely dissolved.

Solvent: A liquid that will dissolve a material to form a solution, i.e., water, alcohol, mineral spirits, etc.

Spreader: A compound that increases the surface area that a given volume of product will cover. Also called a film extender.

Sticker: A compound that increases the retention of a spray or dust on a surface.

Surfactant: Surface active agents. Used in a variety of applications including cleaning, emulsifying, and reducing surface tension (making water wetter).

Suspension: Finely divided particles mixed in a liquid that do not settle.

Synergism: The joint activity of two or more ingredients that is greater than the sum of their individual activities.

Synergist: An individual ingredient that produces synergism with an active ingredient to boost performance.

ULV: Ultra low volume. An insecticide so concentrated that very little volume of product is needed in 5 to 20 micron particles to treat a large volume of space (see micron).

USDA: United States Department of Agriculture. The USDA controls and inspects red meat, poultry and rabbit processing plants. The USDA HACCP Program restricts inappropriate product usage for certain applications. Products must be suitable for intended application and appropriate documentation of applicability may be required.

Vapona: A more common name for DDVP, one of the active ingredients in many insecticides targeting flies.
